

Taxpayers Association President & CEO Traveling to United Arab Emirates - Sharjah to Teach University of San Diego's Course on Innovation in Government

SAN DIEGO (Nov. 21, 2016)--- San Diego County Taxpayers Association President & CEO Haney Hong is teaching a week-long course titled "Innovation Management for Government Leaders" in Sharjah beginning Tuesday. Hong has been an adjunct faculty member of University of San Diego since January 2014, and this is his second time instructing the course in the United Arab Emirates.

The course is centered on exploring how emerging leaders can best grow their abilities to focus the exploration of themselves, others and their organizations, so they can lead lasting change. Students learn to implement strategies to create and develop a culture of innovation and apply tools and tactics to implement innovative strategies in government.

"I look forward to teaching about Innovation in Government, especially given the role that the Taxpayers Association has in promoting good governance and effective public leadership," Hong said. "My time at SDCTA has reinforced my belief in the need for innovation at all levels of government."
