November 2010 Ballot Recommendations

STATE PROPOSITIONS

Proposition 20: YES*

Redistricing of Congressional Districts. Initiative Constitutional Amendment.

Proposition 22: YES

Prohibits the State from Taking Funds Used for Transportation or Local Government Projects and Services.

Proposition 27: NO

Eliminates State Commission on Redistricting. Consolidates Authority for Redistricting with Elected Representatives. Initiative Constitutional Amendment and Statute.

SDCTA will be issuing recommendations on additional State Propositions in early October.
